
Each participant may bring one friend or family member to photograph and video the day's proceedings. For a small fee of £5 they may join the participants for lunch also.

Do you dream of running a magnificent, steam driven beam engine?

Or may be you know someone whose ambition has always been to lift the valves of a Beam Engine or stoke a Lancashire Boiler?

If so, then our one day programme **Experience Steam at Papplewick Pumping Station** is just for you.

There are two dates available for 2017:

Saturday 27th May & 26th August. Group size is strictly limited, so early booking is recommended.

As well as helping to stoke the hand fired Lancashire boilers, you will also get the opportunity to run one of the original twin beam engines, built by James Watt & Co. in 1884 and the 1922 Robey Winding Engine previously of Linby Colliery.

You will also enjoy a guided tour around the Pumping Station and the 1879 reservoir.

Lunch and refreshments will be provided and you will receive complimentary membership to the Papplewick Association giving you free unlimited access on open days and steaming events for a whole year.

The aim of the workshop activities is to afford you the opportunity to enjoy a unique hands on experience. All workshop activities are led by experienced volunteers. The nature of the day requires all participants to heed carefully the instructions of our volunteers at all times to ensure safety.

You are advised to wear comfortable old clothing and stout shoes (a boiler suit is recommended). Participants must be over 18yrs and moderately fit to take part.

Tuition will be in small groups. Each group will work on a carousel basis to enable all participants to cover the three main workshop activities and enjoy the broadest range of experience possible on the day.

Maximum & Minimum Numbers

Each Experience Steam day can take a maximum of 10 participants. But we require a minimum of 3 participants for the day to go ahead.

On the rare occasion that only two bookings or less are received for either date we will reschedule the session to May 28th and August 27th. The programme will remain the same except that it will be a public steaming day. Please ensure that you keep these extra dates free should we have to reschedule.
